

**CONDITIONS OF USE OF THE BARTONS WAR MEMORIAL  
PLAYING FIELDS**

These playing fields are owned by the above registered charity which was established in memory of those residents of the parishes of Steeple Barton and Westcote Barton who served their country during the two world wars. Although primarily intended for the enjoyment of the residents of the two parishes, visitors are very welcome.

- 1) To ensure full and safe use of these playing fields, all users are asked to treat the facilities with respect, to comply with any rules and policies set by the Management Committee, to place litter in the bins provided and to be especially aware that children of all ages use the playing fields.
- 2) Young children must be supervised at all times.
- 3) For reasons of health and hygiene, with the exception of guide and medical dogs, *no dogs are allowed on any part of the site.*
- 4) When using the car park, please park safely and observe the 10 mile per hour speed limit. Parking is entirely at your own risk.
- 5) Anyone intending to use remote controlled aircraft, vehicles or other similar items on this site must have appropriate insurance as they will be personally liable for any injury or damage caused.
- 6) Alcoholic drinks may only be consumed within the boundaries of the playing fields if they are purchased from the Sports and Social Club
- 7) *The fund disclaims any liability for loss or damage to vehicles or property brought onto the site.*
- 8) If any person or organisation is deemed by the Management Committee of the Fund to have abused their use of the facilities in any way, then the Committee may impose a ban on future use of the playing fields by that person or organisation. This ban may be for a specific period, or until certain conditions have been met, or for life.
- 9) The Management Committee will be the sole arbiter in any case of conflict and in the interpretation of Policies, Rules and Regulations.
