
THIS DEED is made the Thurs day of August by N. RMAN HENRY CROSS of Church Farm, Steeple Barton in the County of Oxford and ROBERT JARVIS of North Street, Middle Barton in the said County of Oxford and ROBERT FLEMING of Barton Abbey, Steeple Barton aforesaid (hereinafter called "the Trustees")-WHEREAS: By a Conveyance made the 28th day of June 1948 the property more particularly described in the First Schedule hereto (hereinafter called "the Trust premises") was conveyed by William John Constable to Philip Fleming, the said Norman Henry Cross and the said Robert Jarvis as joint tenents as Trustees of the Bartons' Victory Memorial Hall Fund upon trust for the benefit of the inhabitants of the Parishes of Steeple Barton and Westcote Barton-The said Conveyance stipulated that the administration of the said Trust and the management and conduct of the Trust premises would be regulated by a Deed to be executed by the Trustees-3. The Trustees are the present Trustees of the said Trust N O W in pursuance of the said stipulations THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:-1. THE Trustees shall forthwith make application to the Charity Commissioners for England and Wales for an Order vesting the Trust premises in the Official Custodian for Charities. THE general management and control of the Trust premises and the arrangements for their use shall be vested in the Committee of Management (hereinafter called "the Committee") consisting of six members subject to the powers and provisions set out in the Second Schedule hereto-THE FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL THOSE two freehold closes of land situate and being at Middle Barton aforesaid and in part on the west side thereof adjoining Worton Road and being approximately seven acres and three quarters of an acre which said property for the purposes of identification only and not by way of delimitation are more particularly delineated on the plan annexed to the said Conveyance and thereon coloured pink

## THE SECOND SCHEDULE

- 3. All members of the Committee shall retire annually at the Annual General Meeting. Every organisation entitled to appoint a member of the



(when necessary) with the consent of the Charity Commissioners from time to time by mortgage or otherwise obtain such advances on the security of the Trust Premises or any part thereof as may be required for maintaining extending or improving the same or any part thereof or erecting any building thereon or for the work carried on therein and may continue to repay in whole or in part and from time to time any existing mortgage or charge on the said premises
